



NELCOMETO CLERMONT-FERRAND!

The city of Clermont-Ferrand, or just "Clermont" is located in the Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes Region which is the second largest and wealthiest region in France, after Paris and the Ile de France region.

Clermont is the gateway to the central mountainous area of France called the "Massif Central" and the "Chaîne des Puys" National Park which became France's first natural UNESCO World Heritage site in 2018. The city is surrounded by breath-taking scenery formed by extinct volcanoes and fertile agricultural plains. It is an exceptional and privileged setting for life as a student.

You can catch a direct train in three hours or a flight to Paris in less than one hour. Two highways directly link the city to Bordeaux (West) and Lyon (East) as well as Paris (North) and Montpellier (South).

As a former industrial city, Clermont has evolved into a "métropole" with renewed economic and cultural drive providing a great quality of life. The city and surrounding area are becoming a trendy destination for tourists.



ESC Clermont business school is located in a historic area close to the city centre and the medieval part of the city. Our campus is housed in two adjoining buildings and one annex. Over 12 000 students have graduated since the school was created by the local Chamber of Commerce and prominent businessmen in 1919.

Students have access to modern classrooms, study rooms, student associations, laboratories and leisure facilities.

CITY LIFE

One out of seven inhabitants is a student, ranking* Clermont as one of the top French student cities. The average cost of living

makes it the **8th most affordable city to study in France**. You would have to increase your budget by about 50% to live in the French capital. (see Student life for more details).*

In Clermont you will have plenty of opportunities to meet students from many fields and horizons. We guarantee you countless access to leisure and cultural activities throughout the year! Clermont is – to put it simply – a playground by nature.

Access to the different parts of the city is easy with a great choice of transports to choose from (tram, bus, bike). If you live close to the city centre, most facilities (markets, two shopping centres, boutiques, restaurants and bars) are just a 5 to 30mn walk away.

Sports

If you are a sports-lover, you will have plenty of great games to watch. Clermont has one of the best European rugby teams (ASM Clermont Auvergne), three national hockey, basketball and football teams (Sangliers Arvernes, JAVCM and Clermont Foot63).

The city itself offers **numerous sports facilities**, including stadiums, gyms and swimming pools, which means that whatever sport you are into, there is a place to practice it. Clermont's proximity to an outstandingly unspoilt mountainous area, makes it so easy to enjoy outdoor activities like skiing, hiking, mountain-biking,

paragliding and even windsurfing. All are accessible within an hour's drive



A 'Local-Global' Economy

The Clermont-Auvergne 'metropole' is home to the corporate headquarters of Michelin which was founded by the Michelin brothers more than 100 years ago. Other well-known international companies such as Constellium, Limagrain, Volvic and Théa and consulting firms such as KPMG, Sopra-Steria or CGI are based in and around the city. Many smaller innovative start-ups linked to the Clermont Auvergne French Tech initiative are emerging alongside the many remaining century-old industrial companies which continue to thrive. The city's attractivity is further enhanced by its efficient public services and infrastructures provided by the state, the local region and the city itself.



If you love going to concerts, shows and plays, you will be happy to learn that Clermont has a National Theatre (La Comédie de Clermont), a National Orchestra (and its Opera), two major concert halls (La Coopé, le Zénith), four museums, seven movie theatres... and many other venues (art galleries, bars, bookshops, libraries, ...), your cultural agenda will always be busy.

Clermont is also host to two major international festivals, an International Short Film Festival (the 2^{nd} biggest movie festival in France after Cannes) which takes place in February and the **Europavox** music festival dedicated to emerging and famous European bands during summer.

And, of course, Clermont is a great place for food and wine!

BACHELOR IN INTERNATIONAL MANAGEMENT

After a High School Diploma, A-levels or equivalent This is a 3-year programme taught in English by academics who work closely with local firms conducting research and made-to-measure training programs. Our teaching combines theory with real-world professional experiences in a multicultural environment.

Having completed the international curriculum, Bachelor Degree-holders can either integrate the business world or join a Master's program in France or abroad.

MANAGEMENT

After the Bachelor's Degree The programme aims at preparing, training and developing successful business managers who possess the necessary business knowledge, professional experience, unique skills and an international mindset to become leaders of an ever-changing business world.

Students of the Master in Management programme can benefit from:

- Solid business and management training needed to become a future manager
- A dual-degree or dual-competence certificate
- A specialization obtained in the school or from a partner university abroad
- Professional experience obtained through the different options (internships, gap year, work-study track)
- A joint Master of Science diploma



After a 4-year Bachelor Degree or a Validated Master 1 The Master of Science is a specialized Master's programme that provides students with expertise in a specific area of specialization or domain. Students will also acquire general managerial skills and experience that are essential to gaining an outstanding career in any field.

The Master of Science deploys a dynamic and innovative approach to teaching, one that reinforces practice through different learning methods: face-to-face learning, case studies, company projects, lectures by professionals and coaching.

Students combine theory and practice and develop their skills in many fields including:



Unites creative minds in a vast range of fields, including journalism, graphic web-design, art, photography, exhibitions, music...


